

Kitty Cat Hat

Inspired by Bev's Bear Beanie and my favorite winter hat when I was little



Gauge:
3dc=1inch
2 rows dc= 1inch

Yarn:
Bernat Softee Baby blue; scraps of red, green, and black (I don't know what type of yarn, it's some we've had forever) It doesn't really matter

Hook:
I *think* size H, but I'm not positive. It doesn't really matter, just fit the gauge.

Head (with blue):

Ch 2

Rnd 1: 8 dc in 2nd chain from hook, join w/ sl st to first dc (8 dc)

Rnd 2: 2 dc in each st around, join w/ sl st (16 dc)

Rnd 3: *1 dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, repeat from * around, join w/ sl st (24 dc)

Rnd 4: *1 dc in next 2 dc, 2dc in next dc, repeat from * around, join w/ sl st (32 dc)

Rnd 5: *1 dc in next 3 dc, 2dc in next dc, repeat from * around, join w/ sl st (40 dc)

Rnd 6: *1 dc in next 4 dc, 2dc in next dc, repeat from * around, join w/ sl st (48 dc)

Rnd 7-12: dc in each st across, join w/ sl st (48 dc)

Ears (make 2 with blue):

Ch 8

Row 1: sk 1st ch, sc in every chain across (7sc)

Row 2: sc2tog, sc every stitch across (6sc)

Row 3: sc2tog, sc every stitch across (5sc)

Row 4: sc2tog, sc every stitch across (4sc)

Row 5: sc2tog, sc every stitch across (3 sc)

Row 6: sc2tog, sc in next stitch (2sc)

Row 7: sc2tog (1sc)

Finish off, leaving a long tail for weaving in

Eyes (make 2, starting with black):

Ch2

Rnd 1: 4 sc in 2nd chain from hook (4sc)

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc across (8sc)

Switch to green

Rnd 3: sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2hdc in same st as last sc, dc in next 3 sc (6 sc, 2 hdc, 3 dc)

Finish off, leaving a long tail for weaving in

Nose (with red):

Ch2

Row 1: 2 sc into 2nd ch from hook (2 sc)

Row 2: 2 sc into next sc, 1 sc into next sc (3 sc)

Row 3: 2sc into next sc, 1 sc into next sc, 2 sc into next sc (5 sc)

Row 4: 2 sc into next sc, 1 sc into next 3 sc, 2 sc into next sc (7 sc)

Finish off, weaving a long tail for weaving in

Whiskers (with black)

1. cut 2 6inch strands of yarn and two 3 inch strands.
2. On the back of the nose make a tassel on one side by inserting the hook into a strand of the nose, wrapping one of the 6in strands around the hook so that there are 3in on each side, pulling the nose strand over the hook, pulling the ends of the 6in strand through the loop, pulling the loop off the hook, and pulling the ends to tighten.
3. Tie one of the 3 inch strands around the knot of the tassel
4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 on the other side of the nose's back
5. Trim the ends so that all the whiskers are the same length

ATTACHING THE CAT

If you're confused, look at the picture. I hope it helps

Eyes:

Using the tail from the crocheting and a yarn needle, sew on the eyes so that the narrower green part is on top and the pointy-ish part is facing inward.

Ears:

Using the tail from the crocheting and a yarn needle, sew on the ears so that they are a little to either side of the center.

Nose:

Using the tail left over from crocheting and a yarn needle, sew the nose on to the head a little below the center. Sew all the way around the nose, making sure you leave the whiskers free.
